EXECUTIVE ORDER NO.14 S. 2020
ESTABLISHING THE "KAWANI, KATUWANG SA GULAYAN" PROJECT
WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF GABALDON

WHEREAS, in support with the "Plant, Plant, Plant Program or Ahon Lahat Pagkaing Sapat (ALPAS) laban sa COVID-19 of the Department of Agriculture, the Municipal Government of Gabaldon Nueva Ecija launches the "Kawani, Katuwang sa Gulayan" Project that will be participated by all government employees of the Local Government Unit of Gabaldon, Nueva Ecija, whether permanent employees, job order employees, regular employees or co-terminuous employees;


WHEREAS, the "Kawani, Katuwang sa Gulayan" Project is a reintroduction of basic agriculture and promotion of indigenous vegetable production through backyard gardening in our local community. It shall also promote the consumption of vegetables which have rich resources of protein, vitamins, minerals and fibers;

WHEREAS, it is evident that we are all affected by the recession of our local economy due to pandemic and the "Kawani, Katuwang sa Gulayan" Project shall serve as additional source of food to ensure food accessibility and availability in the municipality;

WHEREAS, the municipal employees and officials are enjoined to encourage other family members and neighbours to plant vegetables in their backyard. Planting materials which consist of various vegetable seeds as well as fertilizers will be provided by this Local Government Unit, and the Office of the Municipal Agriculture is tasked to formulate parameters for the implementation, monitoring and supervision of this noble project;

NOW THEREFORE I, ATTY. JOBBY PETINES EMATA, Local Chief Executive of Gabaldon, Nueva Ecija by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Constitution and laws do hereby order that all employees and officials shall have their own vegetable garden within their backyard.
