**“RECONSTITUTING THE ANTI-ILLEGAL ACTIVITY TASK FORCE”**

**WHEREAS**, Public Safety and General Welfare are among the priority programs of the municipal government;

**WHEREAS**, there exists a need to assist the law enforcement authority with regard to information and apprehension of illegal activities in the municipality;

**WHEREAS**, to fully expedite the apprehension and prosecution of the law violators, the cooperation and participation of the public is necessary;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, ROBERTO O. PALOMAR**, *Municipal Mayor* of the Municipality of Tapaz, Capiz, Philippines, by virtue of the power vested in me by law as the Local Chief Executive, do hereby order “*Creating the Anti-illegality Task Force*” to wit:

1. **COMPOSITION.** The Anti-illegal Activity Task Force shall be composed of:

**Vice Chairs:** SB Representative-Committee on Peace and Order

**Members:** Municipal Health Officer  
Municipal Information Officer  
MENRO  
Chief of Police-Tapaz PNP

CO-Army Representative  
All Punong Barangay  
Head-Tapaz Security Force

2. **STRIKE FORCE TEAM.** A Strike Force Team shall be organized to facilitate speedy apprehension of all illegal activity in the municipality be composed of:

**Anti-illegal Activity Task Force**  
**Strike Force Team**

**Team Leader:** MENRO  
**Team Members:** Tapaz Security Force  
Police/Army  
Barangay Representative  
Media/Municipal Information Office Representative

3. **DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS.** The Council shall have the following duties and functions:
  - a. Coordinate information with regard to illegal activities;
  - b. Assist in the apprehension of the law violators;

- c. Monitor prosecution of the offenders;
  - d. Disseminate information and education campaign of on-going local and national program with regard to law enforcement campaign;
  4. **MEETINGS.** The council shall convene at least once a month, particularly on the second Tuesday of the month, or on the date so ordered by the Chairman.
