RE-CONSTITUTING THE TAPAZ LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD

WHEREAS, it is necessary to constitute a functional entity that will determine local policies in education and the disposition of financial resources for the promotion of education;

WHEREAS, such an organization may also determine and decide on concerns related to school building programs and procurement of school facilities;

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to reconstitute the Tapaz Local School Board in compliance RA 7160 as there is a new set of members;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ROBERTO O. PALOMAR, Municipal Mayor, Tapaz, Capiz, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, hereby issue and promulgate this order;

Section 1. There is reconstituted in Tapaz, Capiz, a Local School Board.

Section 2. The Local School Board shall have the following members;

Section 3. Duties and function of the Local School Board are as follows:

1. Determine, in accordance with the criteria set by Department of Education, the annual supplemental budgetary needs for the operation and maintenance of public schools within the municipality, as the case may be, and the supplementary local cost of meeting such needs, which shall be reflected in the form of an annual school board budget corresponding to its share of the proceeds of the special levy on real property constituting the special education fund and such other sources of revenue as the Code and other laws or ordinances may provide;
2. Authorize the municipal treasurer, as the case maybe, to disburse funds from the special education fund pursuant to the budget prepared in accordance with applicable existing rules and regulations;
3. Serve as an advisory committee to the Sangguniang Bayan on educational matters such as, but not limited to, the necessity for the uses of local appropriations for educational purposes, and;
4. Recommend changes in the name of public schools within the territorial jurisdiction of the LGU for enactment by the Sangguniang Bayan.

Section 4. This order takes effect immediately and shall remain in effect until repealed.

Section 5. This order rescinds all other issuances inconsistent with the foregoing.
