RECONSTITUTING THE TAPAZ MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Title six Section 106 of the Local Government Code is the Local Development Council which paragraph (a) states that each local government unit shall have a comprehensive multi-sectoral development plan to be initiated by its development council and approved by its sanggunian.

NOW THEREFORE, I, HON. ROBERTO O. PALOMAR, Municipal Mayor, Municipality of Tapaz, Province of Capiz by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. Reconstituting the Tapaz Municipal Development Council.

SECTION 3. Power and function of the Tapaz Municipal Development Council shall;

1. Formulate long-term, medium term, and annual socioeconomic development plans and policies;
2. Formulate medium – term and annual public investment programs;
3. Evaluate and prioritize socioeconomic development programs and projects;
4. Formulate local investment incentives to promote the inflow and direction of private capital;
5. Coordinate, monitor, and evaluate the implementation of development programs and projects; and
6. Perform such other functions as may be provided by law or competent authority.


SECTION 4. The Secretariat

The secretariat of the Tapaz Municipal Development Council shall be headed by the Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY

This order shall take effect immediately and remain in force until rescinded.
