RE-CONSTITUTING THE LOCAL COMMITTEE ON ANTI-TRAFFICKING AND VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND THEIR CHILDREN (LCAT-VAWC)

Whereas, Republic Act no. 9208 declares that the State shall give highest priority to the enactment of measures and development of programs that will promote human dignity, protect the people from violence and exploitation, eliminate trafficking in persons and mitigate pressures for involuntary migration;

Whereas, Republic Act no. 9262 underscores the commitment of the State on safeguarding the dignity of women and children while guaranteeing full respect of their human rights and protect them from violence and threats to their personal safety and security;

Whereas, joint memorandum circular no. 2010-1 of DILG, DSWD and DOJ dated October 18, 2010, directing all local government units to create a local committee on anti- trafficking and violence against women and their children;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ROBERTO O. PALOMAR, Municipal Mayor of Tapaz, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the re-constituting of THE LOCAL COMMITTEE ON ANTI-TRAFFICKING AND VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND THEIR CHILDREN (LCAT-VAWC).

Section II. Functions

1. Institute policies and programs to protect women and children who are victims of trafficking and violence (formulate local ordinances and resolutions).
2. Create and establish systems on surveillance, investigation and rescue to ensure effective and efficient coordination.
3. Undertake information, education and advocacy campaign against trafficking in persons and VAWC.

4. Monitor and oversee the strict compliance of RA 9208, RA 9262 and other related laws for the protection of women and children and of the LCAT and VAWC national plans of action.

Section III. Secretariat

Secretariat support shall be lodged with the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Officer who shall be responsible for the documentation of proceedings of meetings and preparation or reports and other necessary documents as needed by the council.

Section IV. Effectivity

This order shall take effect immediately.
