"MANDATORY TESTING FOR COVID-19 OF ALL PERSONS DEPRIVED OF LIBERTY (PDL) BEFORE COMMITMENT TO JAILS AND PRIOR TO RELEASE"

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte on March 8, 2020 issued Proclamation No. 922 declaring the country under the State of Public Health Emergency, and the World Health Organization (WHO) already declared CoVid-19 as a public health emergency of international concern;

WHEREAS, the reported number of infected persons and the number of death due to CoVid-19 continue to increase in the country;

WHEREAS, the overcrowded condition of our jails and other penal facility renders social distancing and other preventive measures against CoVid-19 difficult, thus making the jail personnel and the persons deprived of liberty (PDL) highly vulnerable to the spread of the disease;

WHEREAS, the Department of Interior and Local Government issued a memorandum last May 13, 2020 enjoining all LGUs to require the Philippine National Police (PNP) and National Bureau of Investigation (NBI), and other agencies the testing for CoVid-19 of Persons Deprived of Liberty (PDL) before commitment to Jails and Prior to Release;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ROBERTO O. PALOMAR, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Tapaz, Capiz, Philippines, by virtue of the power vested in me by law as the Local Chief Executive, do hereby order the **"MANDATORY TESTING FOR COVID-19 OF ALL PERSONS DEPRIVED OF LIBERTY (PDL) BEFORE COMMITMENT TO JAILS AND PRIOR TO RELEASE"**;

FURTHERMORE, let copies of this Executive Order be furnished to all concerned for their information and guidance.

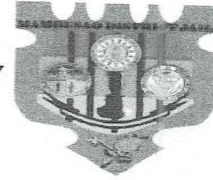


