**"ESTABLISHMENT OF MUNICIPAL AGRICULTURAL CROP PRODUCTION,
LIVESTOCK, AND LIVELIHOOD TRAINING CENTER"**

WHEREAS, Section 17 Par. B (2) of Republic Act 7160 or the Local Government Code of the Philippines mandates that the municipality must provide basic service and facilities such as extension and on-site research and training facilities;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code also provides that within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology and encourage support and development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities;

WHEREAS, in line with the said mandates and principles of the Local Government Code, the Municipality of Tapaz aims to establish a responsible training program for farmers, agricultural workers, and other beneficiaries in the agricultural sector in order to increase agricultural production in a sustainable manner with utmost regard to environmental protection.

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, **I HON. ROBERTO O. PALOMAR**, Municipal Mayor of Tapaz, Capiz hereby order the: **"ESTABLISHMENT OF MUNICIPAL AGRICULTURAL CROP PRODUCTION, LIVESTOCK, AND LIVELIHOOD TRAINING CENTER"**, to wit:

SECTION 1. Objective: The Municipal Agricultural Crop Production, Livestock, and Livelihood Training Center ("Center") is hereby established with the following objectives:

- a. accelerate rural development;
- b. provide agricultural training programs and activities;
- c. improve adoption of new and effective farming practices and technologies;
- d. strengthen farmers resiliency and adaptation to climate change;

SECTION 2. Management: The Municipal Agriculture Office (MAO) under the supervision of the Office of the Mayor shall manage the Municipal Agricultural Crop Production, Livestock, and Livelihood Training Center in order to attain the above-mentioned objectives.

It may enter into agreement, memorandum of understanding, or any other arrangement as may be allowed under the law with National Government Agencies with respect to the management, the conduct of training activities and programs, and other pertinent use of the Center in order to provide and enhance the knowledge, skills and capabilities of farmers, agricultural workers and other beneficiaries in the agricultural sector of the municipality aimed at improving and increasing agricultural production, provide sustainable livelihood for the farmers, and help ensure food security.

SECTION 3. Facility: The Multi-purpose Building located in the Tapaz Public Transport Terminal Compound at the Bypass Road shall serve as the training facility of Municipal Agricultural Crop Production, Livestock, and Livelihood Training Center.

SECTION 3. Budget and Expenses: All expenses incurred relevant to trainings conducted, program development, and management of the facility shall be charged against available funds of primarily the Local Government Unit (LGU) and concerned National Government Agencies like the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA).

Accordingly, upon proper coordination with the MAO, the TESDA and other concerned agencies shall be allowed to conduct training activities and may place their logo at a designated space of the training facility.

SECTION 4. Participation: The Local Government Unit of Tapaz enjoins all barangays, barangay farmers association, farmer's cooperative, non-governmental organizations, academic institutions, and other stakeholders to participate and cooperate in this endeavor by coordinating all training needs and requirements for the promotion of food security and development of their agricultural farming techniques, skills and capabilities.

SECTION 5: Effectivity: This Order shall take effect immediately and shall be enforced until amended or revoked.
