**EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 37-A**

**AN ORDER AMENDING SECTION 2(B) OF EXECUTIVE ORDER 37, SERIES OF 2020, ENTITLED "AN EXECUTIVE ORDER MODIFYING SOME RESTRICTIONS OF THE ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (ECQ) AND DECLARING LA CARLOTA CITY ON A GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (GCQ) STATUS"**

**WHEREAS**, last 20 March 2020, Provincial Governor Eugenio Jose V. Lacson issued Executive Order No. 20-20 placing the entire Province of Negros Occidental in an Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) and last 30 April 2020, issued Executive Order No. 20-20-A extending the duration of the ECQ Over the Province of Negros Occidental until April 30, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, the Provincial Governor upon consultations with all Mayors of the Province issued Executive Order 20-20-B on April 16, 2020, modifying/lifting some restrictions of the ECQ and declaring the entire Province of Negros Occidental in a General Community Quarantine (GCQ);

**WHEREAS**, on 17 April 2020, the undersigned issued Executive Order No. 37 s. 2020 placing La Carlota City under General Community Quarantine and modifying some restrictions of the ECQ;

**WHEREAS**, there were complaints and suggestions as regards the Travel Schedule of the General Public prescribed under Section 2(b) of EO 37 which prompted re-evaluation of said schedule.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, REX R. JALANDO-ON**, City Mayor of La Carlota, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the following measure:

**Section 1.** Section 2 (b) of Executive Order 37 shall read as follows:

"To reduce the volume of vehicles and pedestrians in the Poblacion which would negate the positive gains already achieved by the City in stopping the potential infection and spread of the deadly Corona Virus, a daily **Schedule of Travel** of general public including tricycles, pedicabs (triskads), private vehicles or any other modes of transportation, shall be strictly followed:

**MONDAY**

Provided, that all individuals allowed to travel to and from and within La Carlota City shall present their ECQ issued by their barangays/municipality or city, valid ID and other pertinent documents such as driver's license, tricycle franchise and vehicle registration, as the case may be.

Provided further, that the purpose of travel of individuals is to purchase basic needs such as food, groceries, medicine, supplies and construction materials and to go to banks, remittance centers, and other financial institutions permitted to open.

Exempted from this travel restrictions are public and private sector workers/employees, front liners, and those with medical concerns."

**Section 2.** Any or all Executive Orders previously issued that are inconsistent with this directive shall hereby be deemed revised, repealed or modified accordingly. This order shall be subjected to future revision depending on the future issuances of the Provincial Government and National Agencies.

**Section 3.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing.
